

Application instructions

M1SHOT Quick Detailer Style Maintenance Spray

Maintains and conditions coatings of the Modesta line. May also be used as a standalone protective sealant.

- 1. Wash the vehicle**

Thoroughly wash the vehicle to remove all dirt and contamination. Use the Modesta H-04 Shampoo for the final wash step.
- 2. Apply M1SHOT to a microfiber**

Apply two sprays of M1SHOT to a clean, high quality microfiber and spread evenly on the wet surface. Never spray directly onto the surface! Do not use too much product!
- 3. Wipe with a clean microfiber**

Wipe with a clean dry microfiber until smooth and shiny.

Additional notes

Always ensure that surface is properly cleaned before application. Do not apply to contaminated and dirty surfaces. Test on an inconspicuous place before applying. Never apply at windy or dusty place, in rain, direct sunlight or heat. Surface should have mild (room) temperature before application. Avoid working in too cold or too hot environments. Apply at well-ventilated place.

Do not apply on recently repainted parts. If you are using Modesta on a new car or a car that has been painted, make sure that the paint is properly cured before application. In some cases, the paint on new cars might still be fresh and not fully cured. If you are unsure about the curing stage of the paint then you should wait 4-8 weeks after the vehicle was handed over to you.

Do not combine with other products than those recommended.

Apply only to painted surfaces - never apply to glass, unpainted plastic parts, tires or rubber.

Frequently asked questions

1. How often should I apply M1SHOT to a vehicle protected with Modesta?

After every wash. You should wash the vehicle at least once in every two weeks if it is driving. If it is not driving and stays in a storage, a maintenance wash is still recommended once in every six months.

2. What if I have not washed the car before the application as it was still clean (not driven)?

If the car is just a bit dusty but not dirty you may apply M1SHOT to the dry surface of the paint. Application to a wet surface is not strictly required.

3. Can I use an applicator to apply M1SHOT rather than a microfiber towel?

No. While it might not be completely wrong, it would leave too much product on the paint. Two sprays on a towel per panel is the right amount. Too much M1SHOT might clogg up the microscopic structure of the coating and cause adverse effects in the water behavior.
