Application instructions

M4SMOKE Wet Application Conditioner

Maintains and conditions coatings of the Modesta line. Used for regular maintenance of Modesta coatings.

1.	Wash the vehicle	Thoroughly wash the vehicle to remove all dirt and contamination.
2.	Apply M4 to the wet surface	Apply two sprays of M4SMOKE per panel on the wet paint and spread evenly with a high quality microfiber or wash mitt. Leave on for 2-3 minutes.
3.	Wash off thoroughly with water	Wash off thoroughly with plenty of water, best with a pressure washer.

Additional notes

Always ensure that surface is properly cleaned before application. Do not apply to contaminated and dirty surfaces. Test on an inconspicuous place before applying. Never apply at windy or dusty place, in rain, direct sunlight or heat. Surface should have mild (room) temperature before application. Avoid working in too cold or too hot environments. Apply at well-ventilated place.

Do not apply on recently repainted parts. If you are using Modesta on a new car or a car that has been painted, make sure that the paint is properly cured before application. In some cases, the paint on new cars might still be fresh and not fully cured. If you are unsure about the curing stage of the paint then you should wait 4-8 weeks after the vehicle was handed over to you.

Do not combine with other products than those recommended.

Apply only to painted surfaces - never apply to glass, unpainted plastic parts, tires or rubber.

Frequently asked questions

1. How often should I apply M4SMOKE to a vehicle protected with Modesta?

After every wash. You should wash the vehicle regularly, at least once every two weeks.

2. Will the M4SMOKE have the same effect on untreated paint or coatings of other brands?

M4SMOKE might create a temporary hydrophobic effect on untreated paint, however it will only last a few days and is rather a side effect of one of the ingredients than the intended result. It might work on coatings of other brands, however we can not give any warranties for that.

3. Can I use M4SMOKE on other surfaces than paint?

No. It does not have any adverse effects on plastic, glass or metal parts, but there is no or very limited results.



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
